What is a Gathering?

Fibreshed gatherings are a chance for our interdisciplinary group to come together in person to chat, share ideas, hang out and plant the seeds for something more

What's involved in organising a Gathering

How often are Gatherings?

We aim to have in-person Gatherings at least twice a year: one all-member gathering and one day of coordinated local gatherings. You're welcome to arrange more beyond this, including virtual or hybrid!

Responsibilities of the 'host':

Arrange the space, date and duration. Communicate the details with Fibreshed to invite members. No need for catering but for longer gatherings let people know the options.

How many Gatherings are you organising?

This can be once-off. No pressure to arrange more than one.

Venue requirements:

Offer a space large enough for the group you're planning for. It can be a place of your own or reserve a space in your locality.

Gathering duration:

Up to you but it should be clearly outlined and communicated with members in advance.

Who's invited?

All-member Gatherings should invite Members only, whereas local Gatherings can invite potential Members and the wider community if suitable.
